Green Side Up by Dustin

First, I'd like to thank everyone that participated in Dustin's Revenge 2010 held on October 9th. I really enjoyed setting up the golf course to provide an opportunity to play "something different". I understand the event is handicapped, but I wasn't expecting the ultra low scores. I guess next year I'll need to get a little more twisted....That said, I do

hope the event was enjoyable and worth experiencing again.

The 2010 golf season started early and it continues to extend as the fall weather has been dry and pleasant. As we all know, it can't continue. Weather always averages out and it is safe to assume that it'll all come crashing in very shortly and the end of the season will be upon us. There are several important tasks that must be completed prior to winter's onset. The irrigation blowout is scheduled for November 1st. All snow mold protection products will need to be applied. And finally, the greens will be covered with a layer of topdressing sand to help protect the turf against desiccating winter winds. Historically speaking, weather patterns force these duties to be completed by mid-late November. Once the sand topdressing is applied to the greens, the flags and cups will be removed and all putting surfaces will be closed to play. Once the greens are closed, the course will be reversed, meaning die hard golfers could play from a fairway tee locations to a flag stick located on a tee. In early November, the upper range tee will be closed for aeration and over seeding. Both tees will remain closed for the remaining weeks of the year and all practice play will be restricted to the artificial hitting mat.

Although the grass slows its growth, my to do list for the golf course is constantly being developed. I hope to complete many ongoing projects and maintenance tasks that'll improve conditions next season. Samples from this list include:

- 1 Slice aerate all roughs
- 2 Repair crowned approaches
- 3 Landscape shrubbery and perennial care
- 4 Tree trimming and care
- 5 Irrigation maintenance
- 6 Course cleaning & Final mowing
- 7 Native grass area care
- 8 Removal of all golf course furniture, rakes and stakes
- 9 Deer fencing installation

Colder nights lead to frost delays. Please understand these delays are critical for protecting the turf. Please check with the Golf Shop prior to beginning your morning round to avoid any misunderstandings or potential damage. The 2010 golf season arrived early, brought record rains and temperatures and droughty fall months. Yet, OGC appears to have survived much better than most and I'm excited to continue the progress and improvements for 2011. Happy holidays and safe travels.
